\$5/Day Incentive – Important Updates

IE Commuter’s \$5/Day program offers \$5 in gift cards for each day a commuter rideshares to work in a three-month period—up to \$125.

The program is open to commuters who live in Riverside and San Bernardino counties who are new to ridesharing.

People who work in these counties but live in a different county, as well as those who’d previously claimed \$2/Day incentives, need to have their first month of logged trips entered by Dec. 31.
