

## An Easier Way to Find Commute Options



**Ridematch.info** is the rideshare database for Los Angeles, Orange and Ventura counties, and it's sporting a new, user-friendly design and interface. Log in to instantly generate customized carpool/vanpool matches and transit routing.

The site also features other ridesharing resources, such as Park & Ride lots and EV charging stations.

## Opening Soon: LAX/Metro Transit Center

The much-anticipated **LAX/Metro Transit Center** will open June 6. Metro will mark the occasion with free rides system-wide June 6-8.

Located at Aviation Boulevard and 96th Street in Los Angeles, it offers riders dozens of transit connections to Los Angeles World Airport (LAX).

The station serves local and regional bus lines as well as two light rail lines—the C and K lines. For the first time, riders on the K Line (starting in Redondo Beach) will be able to connect uninterrupted to the E Line at the Expo/Crenshaw Station.

Ultimately, it will include a direct connection to the airport via the LAX Automated People Mover, expected to open early next year.

**Metrolink launched a new alerts tool** last month that makes it easier for riders to track real-time train information, including delays and service interruptions. You'll be able to better time when you need to get to the station or make alternate travel plans if your usual train isn't available.
